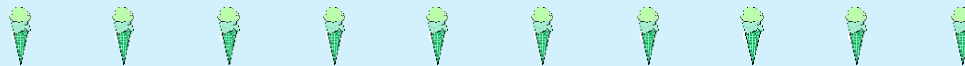
Welcome to the 2015—2016 Dance Season!
